




The reasons behind JODI

Why does the world need energy data transparency (JODI)?




JODI was born in late 90's to address oil prices volatility


JODI started with Oil: The leader of energy sources


Oil price variation impacts other energy prices




Capacity Building

 Since 2006, the IEF and its JODI partner organisations have delivered a series of training programmes on JODI. Through these workshops, we help our participating countries to report better quality data through the JODI questionnaires. These workshops offer professionals responsible for filling JODI questionnaires at national administrations an occasion to clarify JODI definitions and to learn more about data quality assessment techniques. These workshops are also a good opportunity to share their best practices on data validation or to discuss issues on data collection.

Capacity Building


Efforts to Extend JODI-Oil Reach

Intensive Efforts to Extend JODI-Gas Reach






Active Engagement & Capacity Building to make JODI happen
